

PageSafe 1.5.1 release note

This release note describes the new features that can be found in this new version of PageSafe.

Scripting language support	A sophisticated scripting language allows business processes to be built into PageSafe use.
Display optimisation	The way the system displays tasks is now up to ten times faster – allowing very large numbers of tasks and documents to be handled.
Task colouring	Tasks may now be colour coded.
Notifications	Milestones and future documents can be set up to warn in advance regularly remind users of missed deadlines.
Export to MS Project	Projects and tasks can be exported to MS Project mpp format.
Independent scheduling	Tasks and reports can be scheduled to execute independently of human intervention.
Task ordering	Tasks can now be ordered in a view by date, alphabetically, or manually.
Task documents	All documents related to a task can be viewed together in a separate view.
Task navigation	A variety of document navigation options are available including jumping to today, and jumping to an arbitrary date.
Document Search	Documents can be searched for words and phrases. PageSafe can cope with Text, Rich Text Format, PDF, XML, Microsoft Word, and Microsoft Excel file formats.
Shared views	View tabs can now be shared within a group so every member of the group sees the same tab with the same tasks.
Progress bar	Progress bars can be set either in days or as a percentage.
View current tasks only	Views can be uncluttered to show only those items within the current time range.
Runs over the Internet	PageSafe can now be set up and run as a centrally accessible online system over the Internet.
Extensive documentation	A complete help system, user and administrators guide and a reference manual for the scripting language are available.
